Future entries expected to increase due to more specialty clubs joining the circuit and added perks, such as the breed seminars that will start in 2007

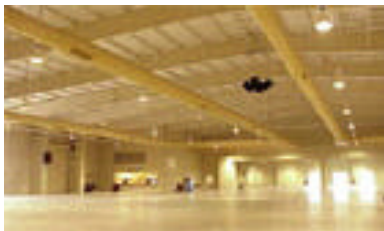
